

Directions

From the North

Take I-93S toward Boston, MA. Take exit 48 toward Methuen to get on MA-213E. Take exit 5A to get on I-495S toward Lawrence. Take exit 44–43 for Merrimack Street. Use the exit ramp on the right to get to Merrimack Street (you will see mill buildings on your right). Take a left at the lights at the bottom of the ramp. At the next set of lights, turn right onto Main Street. Once you get to the Bank of America on your left, turn left onto Water Street. At the next stop sign, you will see SYA’s Home Office located at 120 Water Street, which is the mill building in front of you.

From the South

Take I-93N toward Concord, NH. Take exit 44A to get on I-495N toward Lawrence. Take exit 43 to Massachusetts Ave in North Andover. Turn right on to Massachusetts Ave. In 0.6 mi, take a left onto Greene Street. Follow the signs to stay on Greene Street (you will need to turn left). When you reach the end of Greene Street, turn left onto Main Street, and then immediately right onto Elm Street (by the sign for Machine Shop Village). The first stop sign will intersect with Water Street—SYA’s Home Office is located at 120 Water Street, which is in the mill building on the right.

Parking

We recommend using Lots I, J or L, marked below with light blue arrows. Please note that the entrance to the parking lots are located on High Street (use 57 High Street for GPS directions.) Note that some spaces in Lot I are reserved—do not park in reserved spaces, which are clearly marked. If those lots are full, you should be able to find space in the lot across the street (orange arrow). You can walk through lot M and along the path to the right of the pond (purple line). Enter the door in the corner of the building and take the elevator to level 3. Exit the elevator, go through the door in front of you and straight ahead to the office suite on the right, just before the exit doors to the building. Then ring the bell!



Other ways of getting here

Commuter Rail—from North Station in Boston, take the Haverhill line to Lawrence. The office is 1.6 miles from the commuter rail station, a short Uber/Lyft or taxi ride. (We don’t recommend walking due to the lack of sidewalks between Lawrence and North Andover.)
